**(1) Video Playback** – A data/video projector which displays a video or data image on a screen OR a 27" monitor(s) which is viewable by 30 people.

**(2) Foreign Standard VCR** - Plays Foreign videotapes as well as American videotapes.

**(3) Computer Display Capability** – (MAC/PC). Installed computers have zip, floppy, CD drives and USB access ports for flash drives. Software includes Word, Excel, Powerpoint, Acrobat, Flash, Shockwave, Quicktime, RealPlayer, SFTP and SSH software, Safari, Firefox and Internet Explorer.

**(4) Computer Network Access** – Wired ethernet connection is provided for faculty use with media presentation equipment.

**(5) Disc Players (CD = Compact Disc, LD = Laser Disc, DVD = Digital Video Disc)**

**(5-A) "Code-Free" DVD player** - Plays Foreign DVD's as well as American DVD's.

**(6) Sound Systems** consist of speakers and an audio amplifier.

**(6-A)** Designates that Sound System allows for use of microphone or 16 mm film projection independent of video/data projection system. **Recommended for events where speech reinforcement is the only type of media required.**

**(6-B)** Microphone is for Distance Education and Web Archive only. **No speech reinforcement.**

**(7) Web Archive** - Classroom presentations can be recorded digitally, archived and streamed on the internet for later viewing. Data/Audio Archiving only, (no video). By prior arrangement. Call 459-5790 for information.

**(8) Assistive Listening Devices** are available on request.

**(9) This room has Assistive Listening Capability.**

**(10) This room has one 35 mm Slide Projector.**

**(11) This room has cable TV**

**(12) This room has closed captioning capability.**

**(13) This room has internet access.**
